STEM Fellowship

STEM (<http://stemfellowship.org>) is a national, non-profit, student-run organization that uses mentorship and experiential learning to connect and empower young innovators interested in STEM (science, technology, engineering and math). Please note that it is imperative that all students read the [2022 Applicant Handbook](#) in its entirety prior to beginning the application process.

Our program is open to all grade 11 and 12 students, but we particularly target students from communities traditionally underrepresented in STEM pursuits. Our definition of underrepresented will be based on self-identification and may include indigenous, refugee or economically disadvantaged youth. Applications will be open between December 1st, 2021 and January 15th, 2022.

Student Leadership Conference:

Students who are interested in a leadership conference this year focusing on Student Leadership, Mentorship and Wellness have an opportunity to get involved. The design this year is to have 3 online sessions (between 1-2 hours each) and then have a culminating celebration at the University of Lethbridge in May in person (COVID permitting of course).

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Considering summer school online or CALM online semester two? You will need to complete GO credits for Palliser Beyond Borders.

The Getting Online (GO) prerequisite for online courses with Palliser Beyond Borders is a requirement for each student taking an online course. The GO orientation prepares students to take courses with Palliser Beyond Borders by gaining competence in using information management systems software, working through schedules, discussing the importance of communication with teachers and work plans, and increasing their understanding of working with the Moodle Learning Management System (LMS) and Google Workspace. Upon completion of the orientation, students will receive 5 credits, and will be ready for online learning.

Troubleshooting Notes:

- phone number and email must match Alberta Education records ~ these can be checked at school
- do not use a "prs" email; this email will disappear after you graduate
- you need your Alberta Student Number to sign up (this can be obtained from PowerSchool, at school or your TA)
- a personal "gmail" works well that you will use into adulthood
- if you use a gmail account use "sign in with education account" and follow the instructions (you do not need a "access code" this way - just leave that field blank)
- if you continue to struggle see Ms. Kilbreath (Student Area), Ms. Cressy (front desk), or Mrs. Topp to check/update your personal information that is recorded
