Arenas REP Access Card:

As you may be aware, WinSport has a COVID-19 Restrictions Exemption Program (REP) in place at the Arenas in the Markin MacPhail Centre.

This impacts our students who train at the facilities and those that choose to access the Garden Café at lunch through the REP zone. To make accessing the REP zone more efficient, NSS have worked with WinSport to create a Vaccine Status Card for all NSS students and staff who can show proof of their double vaccination, along with photo ID. If you would like to receive one of these cards, please visit the PTC Guest Services desk, state that you are with NSS and would like to receive your vaccine status card. They will ask for proof of your double vaccination and photo ID. Once you have received this card, you can show it to security to enter the REP zone.

Masks:

Masks are mandatory and must be worn in school, please make sure you are wearing your mask correctly.

Garden Cafe:

Closed until further notice; however, students can use this space to eat their lunch and therefore we are still supervising that area. Students and staff need to show vaccination records to access this area.

Exam Schedule and Credit Recovery:

For Grade 9s:

January 10-24: Regular classes for Grade 9s

Grade 9 Science PAT: January 24 - tentative (awaiting more provincial direction)

January 25-27 for Grade 9: students will be invited into the school for mark improvement that need extra time to support missed learning and struggling to meet course objectives. Teachers will communicate directly with families to request attendance.

Exam Schedule and Credit Recovery:

For Grades 10 to 12:

January 10-18: regular classes resume

January 19-20: credit recovery for students that are at risk of not passing their high school courses. Teachers will communicate directly with families to request attendance.

Exam Week for Grades 10-12:

Final exams or replacement exams will be designed by staff for all grades 10 to 12. Exams will be 60 to 80 minutes in length and delivered during the assigned subject period. Teachers will share this information with each course. These final exams will only support mark improvement. Please discuss individual needs with your subject teacher.
