Message from the Minister's Youth Council Recruitment

I am pleased to announce that recruitment for the 2022/23 Minister's Youth Council will officially begin on February 14, 2022. Of the 40 council members, we will accept up to eight returning members and at least 32 new members. Participating in the council will give students the opportunity to make a real impact on Alberta's education system, build their leadership skills and leave a legacy that will last for generations to come.
